This type of rock has two subtypes: intrusive and extrusive.

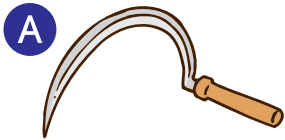




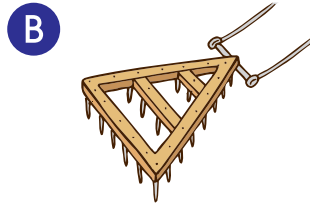
