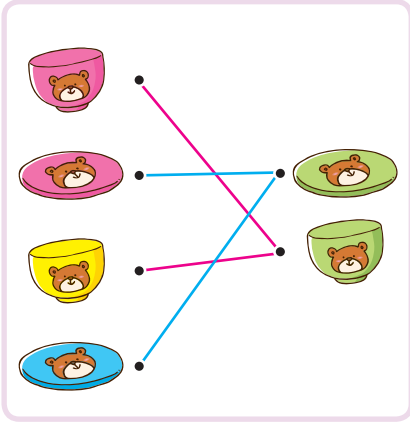

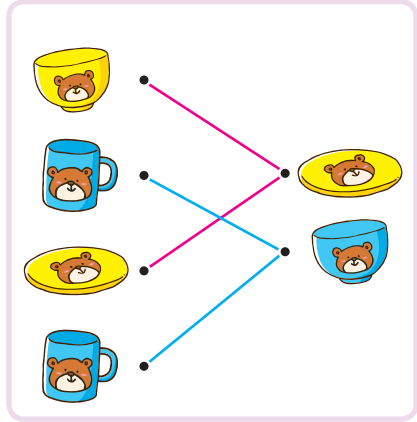
Sorting and Comparing

e.g. **By Type**

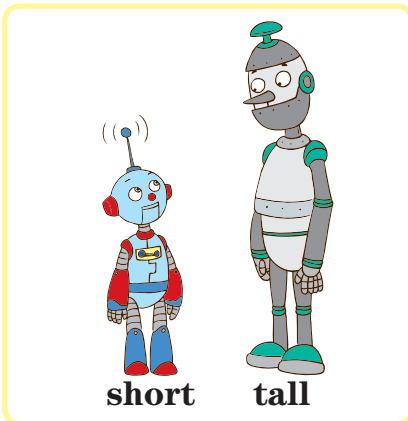


By Colour

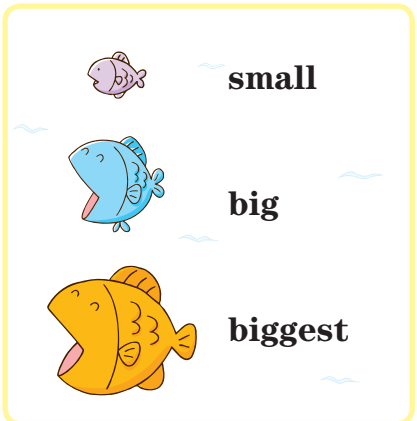


- **Comparing** – comparing sizes, heights, lengths, and weights of different things

e.g. **Comparing Heights**

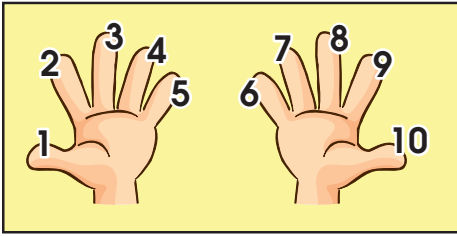


Comparing Sizes

- **Repeating Pattern** – a pattern with a core that repeats

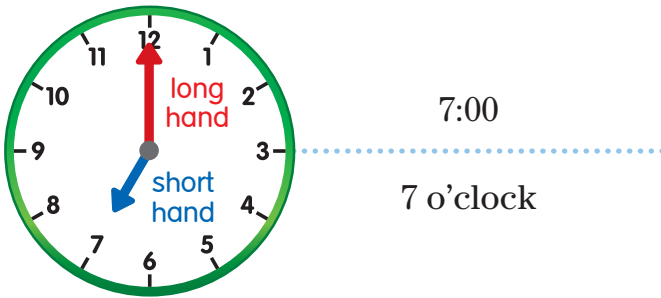

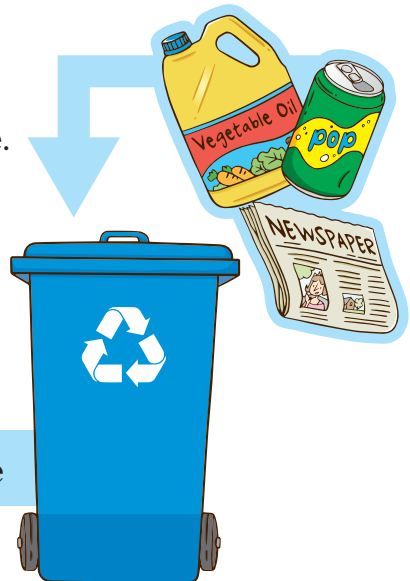


Our Environment

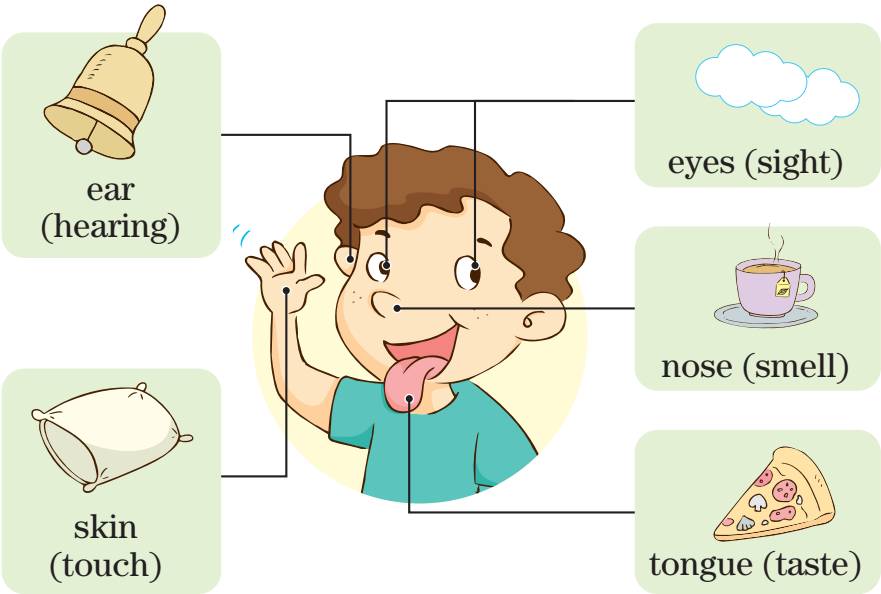

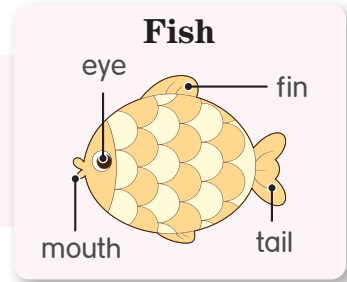

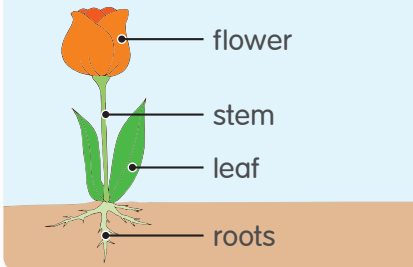


Animals and Plants

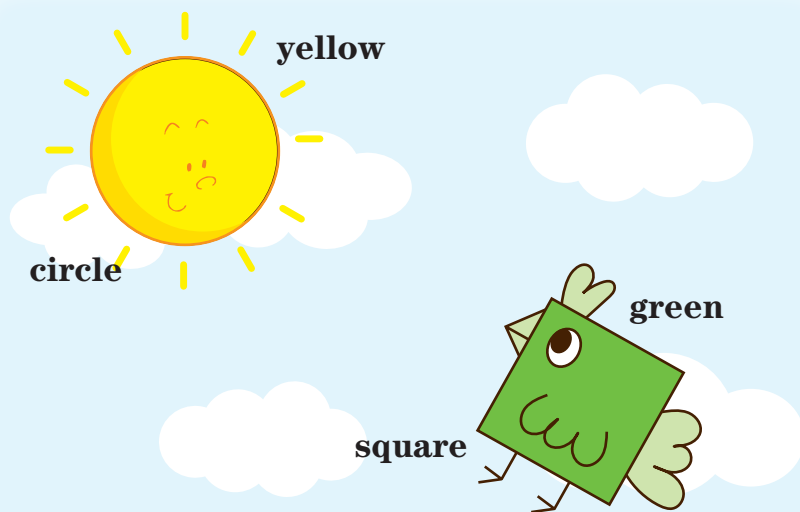
