

A. Some changes in our daily lives occur in cycles. Fill in the blanks to complete the different cycles.


seconds for the Earth to complete a daily cycle / meal

When we are getting into bed for a nice long sleep, someone on the other side of the Earth is getting up!


C. Draw lines to match the thermometers with the pictures.




One day is the time taken for the Earth to complete one turn. The temperature changes as the Earth turns.
