Return to the seventeenth century, as you wander Old Port's cobblestone streets and observe the landmarks that have been preserved since the city was founded. You can learn about history by taking a tour by bus or boat, rent a paddleboat, or simply sit on a bench by the water and enjoy the summer breeze.
