Compound Word Makers



Draw eight pictures that can form four compound words in the boxes on page 197. Cut out the pieces on this page and page 197.

2 or more players

Place the pieces face down. Each player takes turns to draw two pieces. Keep the pieces if the pictures can form a compound word. If not, place the pieces back in the bank. When all the pieces are drawn, the players show their pictures and say as many compound words as they can. The one with the most compound words wins.
