Materials:

- a 2-litre plastic bottle
- scissors
- paint, markers, and decorative items

Steps:

- 1 With the help of an adult, cut the plastic bottle in half. Be sure to leave little animal ears.
- 2 Clean the bottom of the plastic bottle thoroughly.
- 3 Paint the bottle and let it dry.
- 4 Draw a face and other features on the bottle.
- 5 Use your creative container as a pencil holder, snack bowl, or anything else you can think of.

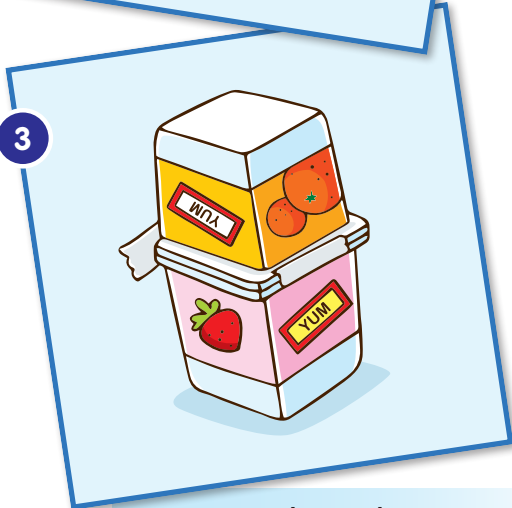
Clean two yogourt cups.

My Desk Organizer

Materials:

- 3 empty toilet paper rolls
- a yogourt plastic lid
- paint and a paintbrush
- a glue gun
- scissors

Steps:

- 1 Cut the toilet paper rolls into different heights.
- 2 Paint them and let them dry.
- 3 Place the rolls upright on the lid and arrange them as you like.
- 4 Ask an adult for help to glue the rolls together with the glue gun. Then glue them on the lid.
- 5 Decorate the rolls with different accessories if you like.
